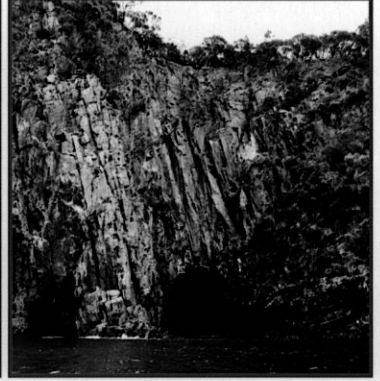
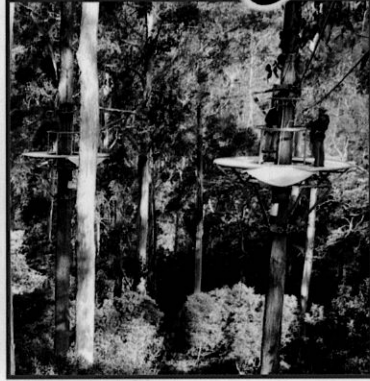


# Travelling to Tasmania
